Microscope - wear appropriate clothing for the given weather



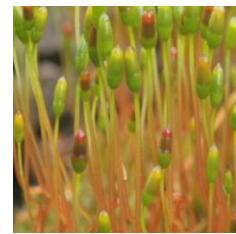
